## Who should participate?

- Is your home's well more than 40 years old?
- Is it less than 50 feet deep?
- Has it been more than a year since the water was tested?

If you answered **yes** to any of these questions, bring a well water sample\* to the Free Fair. Within about 30 minutes, you'll know if there might be a hazardous level of nitrate in it.

## \*To collect your well water sample properly:

- Pick up a sample bottle from Brookville High School office, Miami Valley Career Technology Center Office or the Montgomery Soil & Water Conservation District on Amity Rd. **Any clean jar that seals tightly will also work.**
- Collect the sample on March 11<sup>th</sup> if at all possible.
- Remove any screen or filter from your faucet.
- Run water for five minutes to clear the lines and bring in fresh water.
- Do not touch the lip of the jar, inside the jar, or inside of the cap.
- Fill the bottle and cap it snugly.
- Keep the sample refrigerated until the Test Your Well Fair.
