

Implementation Schedule of Miami Conservancy District's 2009 Activities

The following is Miami Conservancy District's implementation schedule representing a summary of the stormwater activities we plan to undertake from February 1, 2009 to February 1, 2010.

Minimum Control Measure #1: Public Education and Outreach

TRAINING: Miami Conservancy District plans to hold training opportunities for technical audiences and/or facilitate the attendance of key professionals at regional training opportunities.

MCD plans to hold a stormwater workshop in 2009. Financial and promotional support for the Southwest Ohio Sediment and Erosion Control Field Day is also planned for 2009.

TOUR OF STORMWATER BMPs: Miami Conservancy District plans to coordinate a tour of stormwater Best Management Practices for at least 10 practitioners.

In September, 2009, MCD is planning a tour of Best Management Practices in the Great Miami River Watershed.

Minimum Control Measure #2: Public Involvement and Participation

STREAM TEAM: Miami Conservancy District plans to facilitate stream team training for 20 new volunteers throughout the Great Miami River Watershed in the 2009 reporting year.

Miami Conservancy District is planning on facilitating a stream team training for 20 new volunteers within the Great Miami Watershed.

GREAT MIAMI RIVER WATERSHED NETWORK: Miami Conservancy District plans to facilitate four Great Miami River Watershed Network meetings in the 2009 reporting year.

The Great Miami River Watershed Network decided to meet on the first Thursday of the months of March, June, September, and December during 2009.

WATER FESTIVALS: Miami Conservancy District plans to support and participate in two children's water festivals throughout the Great Miami River Watershed in the 2009 reporting year.

MCD will continue to provide financial and staff support to the Dayton Children's Water Festival scheduled for May and the Butler County Water Festival in October.

RIVER CLEAN-UP: Miami Conservancy District will participate and/or donate funds for two clean-ups in the Great Miami River Watershed in 2009.

MCD will continue to assist with the Clean Sweep of the Great Miami River. This annual event cleans up 170 miles of the river from Indian Lake to the Ohio River. MCD will help in planning and fund-raising for the event, organizing a section for the clean-up and donating funds in 2009. MCD will also donate funds to the Stillwater River Clean-up.
